The Jean Crook Memorial Scholarship for \$1,000

Awarded to a well-rounded student who has been affected by a challenging experience that has shaped or changed their life.

To apply, please submit the following:

1. A completed application. (No hand written applications will be accepted)
2. Completed essay of 500 words or less, that **describes areas in your life where you demonstrated leadership and overcame obstacles either through your school, social, or family life.**
3. A SEALED transcript from the guidance department of his/her school. The transcript should include evidence of school involvement.
4. One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or employer.
5. Resume or List of Activities/Achievements may be submitted. (Optional)

Scholarship application deadline is Friday, May 10, 2024.

Please include one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or employer.

Optional

Resume or list of extracurricular school activities, community service, or achievements may be submitted.

All of these pieces are essential for consideration of your application. Failure to submit any of these pieces or incomplete submissions will result in disqualification of your application.

Scholarship application deadline is May 10, 2024.
